2nd Annual Humane Poster & Creative Writing Contest 2012

Jan. 3rd through Feb. 3rd

The Chemung County Humane Society & SPCA, along with the Chemung County Library District and the Southeast Steuben County Library, invite students in kindergarten through eighth grade to participate in the second annual Humane Poster and Creative Writing Contest.

The contest will allow students to think creatively about different animal welfare issues. They will then get to express themselves in meaningful stories and pieces of artwork that will be displayed throughout the Chemung County Library District and the Southeast Steuben County Library. Children who enter will have the chance to win a variety of prizes and to showcase themselves throughout the community as shining examples of compassion.

The contest is broken down into different divisions, depending on grade level. Each division has two separate entry types: writing and poster - except for Division I which only has a poster contest. Prizes will be awarded for first, second and third place in each entry type for each division.

Submission Guidelines

Each individual child is allowed to submit one piece of work for each type of entry for their division. Entry into this contest gives the Chemung County SPCA permission to use students' work in future events and promotions with proper credit given to each student.

Submission Requirements:

All entries must be submitted from students residing either in Chemung or Steuben Counties.

Entries Must Be Original

All entries must be the student's own creative work. Every submission may not contain already created cartoon characters, photographs from magazines, or any other trademarked work. Written entries may be a short story, song, poem or letter. We want all students to be as creative as possible and have fun!

Labeling

Each entry must be accompanied by the official Chemung County SPCA entrance form (found in this packet). Forms must be filled out completely to ensure that we can contact every winner at the end of the contest. Please adhere the form securely to the back of your poster and/or staple it to the top left corner of your written work. If submitting both types of entries, please use both forms and attach the proper form to each entry.

Size

The size of each piece of artwork must not exceed 14x20 inches. Please refer to each individual division requirement (listed on next page) for all written length guidelines.

Deadline

All entries must be received by 7:00 p.m. on February 3. Any entries mailed in to the shelter must be postmarked by the above date. Please mail entries to:

Divisions

Division I: Kindergarten and 1st Grade

Poster Topic

What types of things do families have to do to take care of a pet? Design a poster that shows some of the different jobs involved with taking care of a pet.

Division II: 2nd and 3rd Grade

Writing Topic

What are some things that every family should consider before adopting a new pet? List and explain two things that your family would need to think about before bringing a new pet into your house. (60 to 100 words)

Poster Topic

What should people look for when they are going to adopt a pet? Design a poster informing people on how to pick the best adoptive pet for their family.

Division III: 4th and 5th Grade

Writing Topic

Why should pets have proper forms of identification? What kinds of pet identification are there? Write a composition explaining why it is important for pets to have identification. (100-200 words)

Poster Topic

Why is proper pet identification so important? Create an ad for a newspaper or magazine that educates people on why they should make sure their pets are properly identified.

Division IV: 6th through 8th Grade

Writing Topic

Why is it so important to have pets spayed or neutered? What are some of the benefits of getting pets fixed? Write a speech or a composition that identifies 3 reasons why getting pets spayed or neutered is important. (200-300 words)

Poster Topic

Create an ad for a newspaper or magazine that educates people about some of the benefits of having their pets spayed or neutered.
